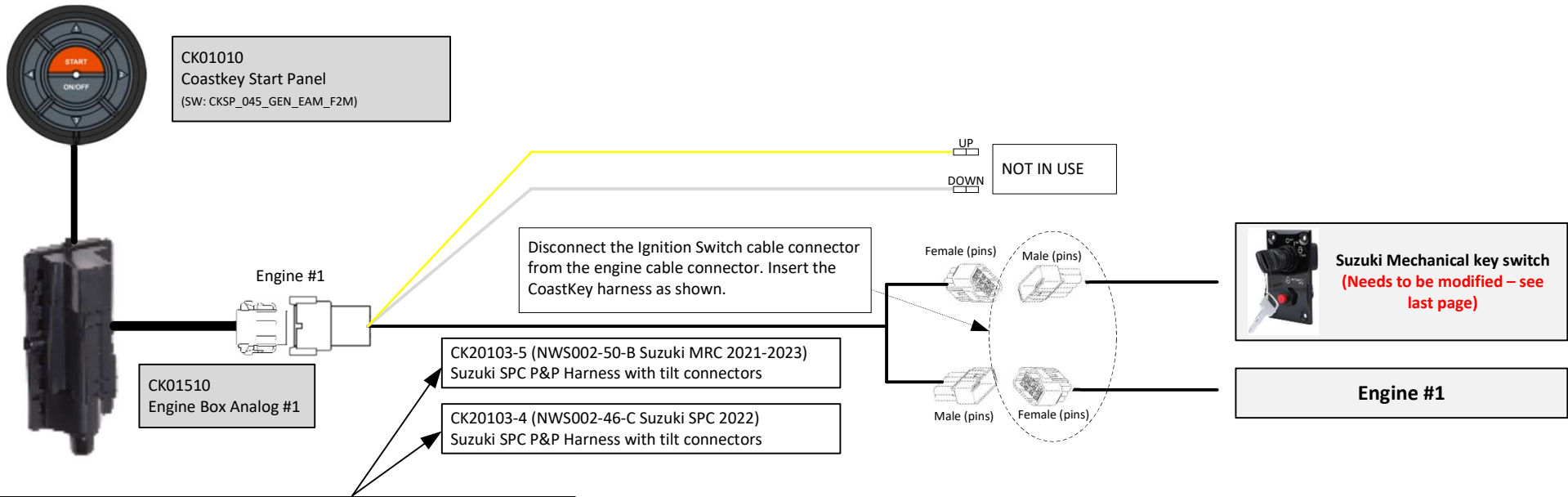


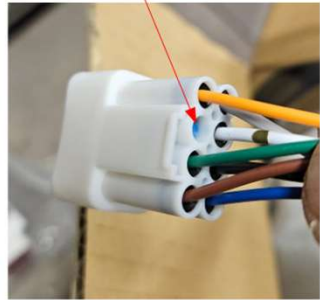
Suzuki Mechanical – MRC 2 (Gen.2): Single Basic installation – C0160-1



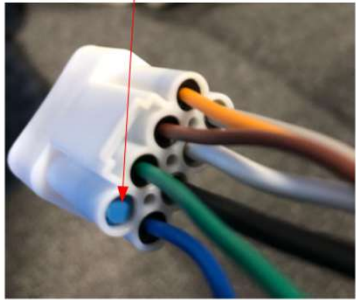
Workaround for MRC model 2021/22 – 2023

To be totally safe and sure what kind of MRC model that is used, we need customer to take a picture of the Furukawa connector on the ignition key:

MRC (Mechanical) 2021/22 – 2023 modell:
- Furukawa pin 7 has no terminated wire



SPC (Drive by wire) all modells from 2021/22 and MRC (Mechanical) modells from 2023:
- Furukawa pin 5 has no terminated wire



Since this is a middle or temporary model, it will likely be a few installations of this one. So, for these few installations we can re-work our SPC cable (NWS002-46-C Suzuki SPC 2022.pdf). I made a new cable drawing for the MRC 2021/22 – 2023 model:

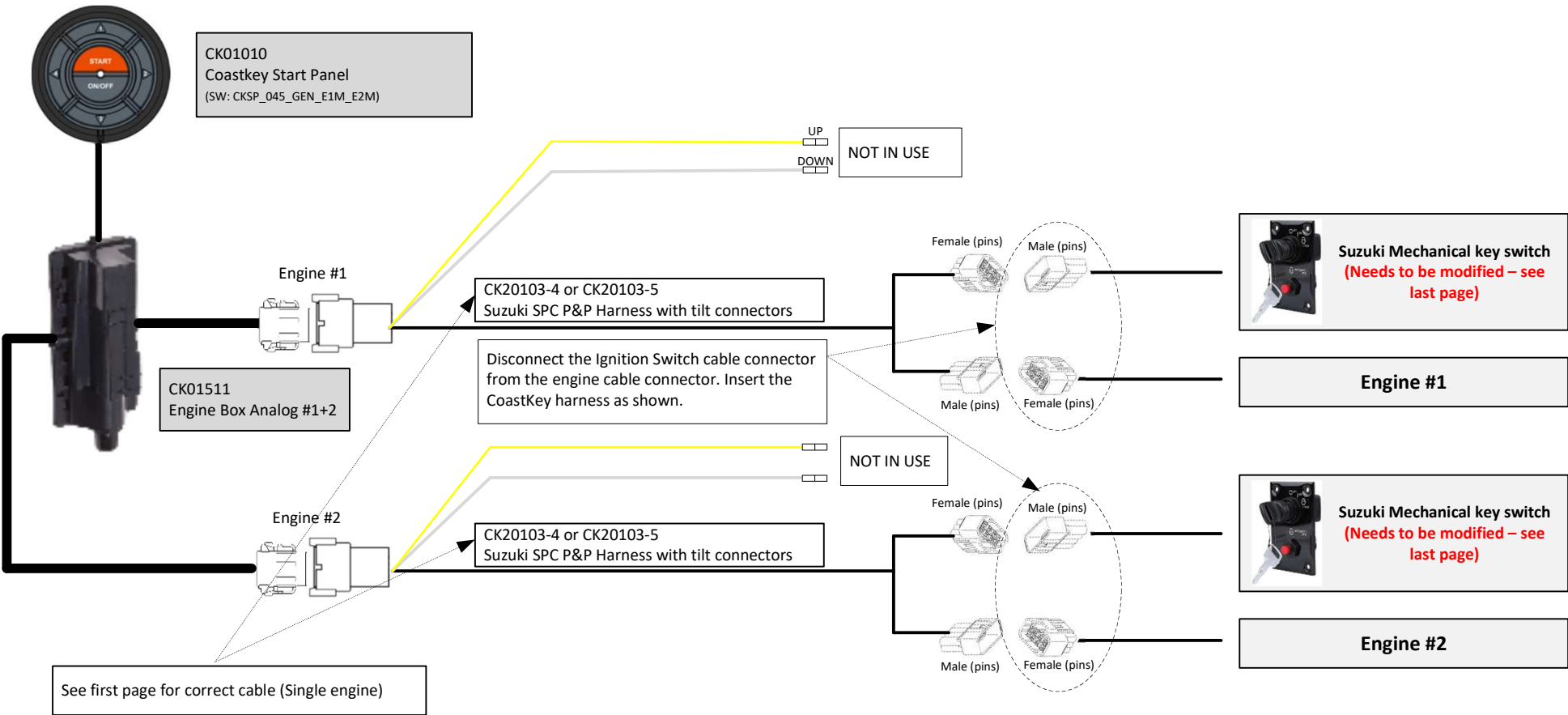
Installations with Suzuki Keyless System (KLS):
This unit need to be de-installed if Coastkey shall be used.

The Suzuki Keyless unit must be de-installed by a Suzuki dealer or service partner! When KLS is de-installed, Coastkey are ready to be installed.

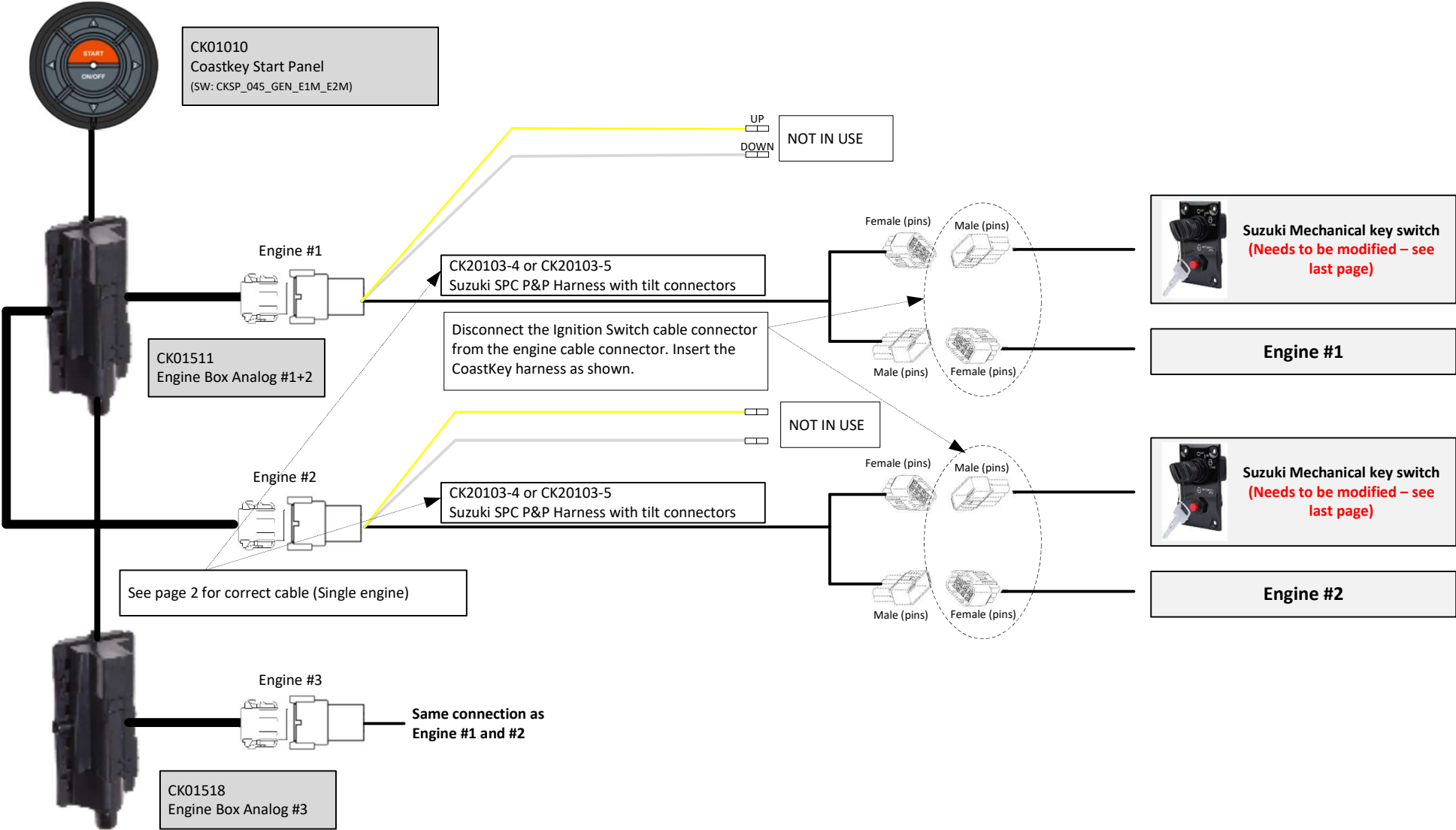
Suzuki Mechanical – MRC 2 (Gen.2): Twin Basic installation – C0260-1

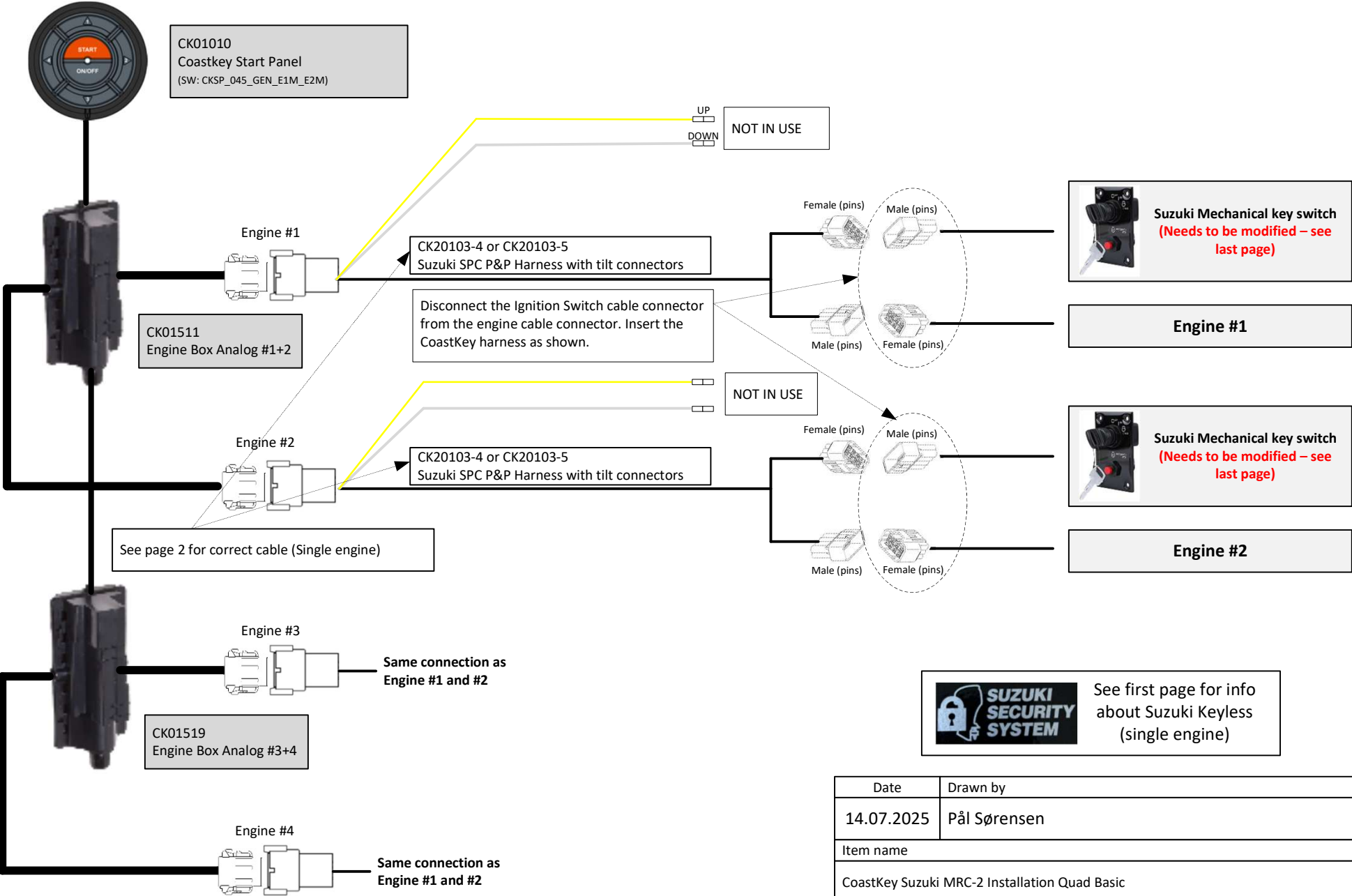

Suzuki Ignition Key Switch Modification

Key switch with two green wires

NOTE!

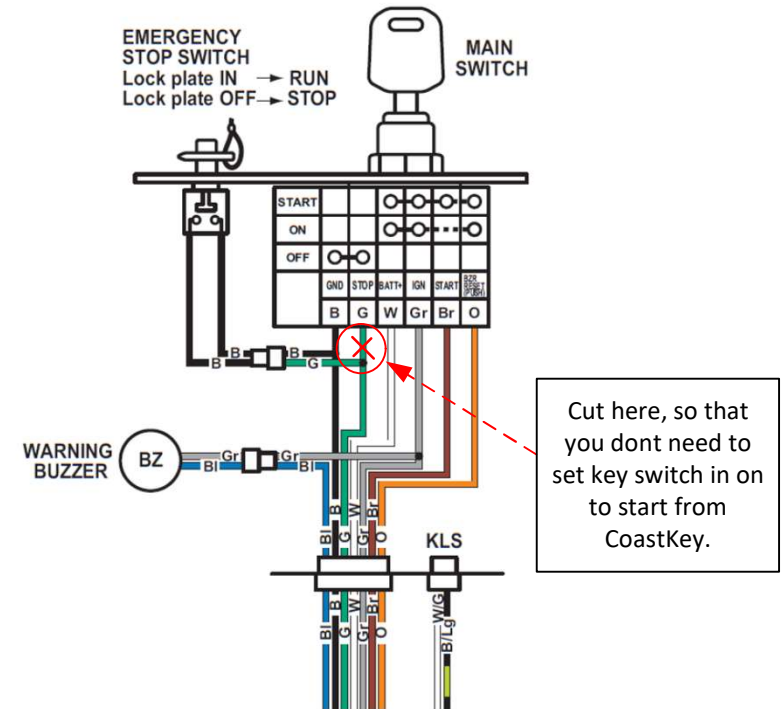
If the key switch is being used, find the green wire(s) from the ignition switch. It is either one green that ends in a split or two green wires.

One green wire:

Cut this between key switch and the split. Isolate the ends.

Two green wires:

Cut both of these, 3 cm from the key switch (fig.1). Splice the two ends together that go to the engine. Isolate or splice the two ends that go into the key switch (fig.2).



When Suzuki KLS is de-installed, it is recommended to insert a mechanical key switch with killswitch and connect this together with Coastkey.

If no key switch shall be mounted, connect the connector from the power/start switch and killswitch to the Coastkey harness – This is to have the manual killswitch still working!
